Construction on-site has been full of activity with Guild establishing some of its key structure with Guild Apartments starting to form.

Guild's Development Manager, Laurence Peck, has estimated the completion of the buildings East Tower to occur in September to October, 2012 with the West Tower estimated for completion late 2012. However, LOOK will provide you with more precise dates upon being advised from the developer.

Since commencing construction Guild has seen the following milestones:

- The ground floor and Level 1

slabs have been poured and are complete.

- The East and West core jumps are complete with the two towers beginning to rise.
- The first of the East facade panels are now installed – starting to show Guild's true architecture.
- Guild's state of the art swimming pool is under construction.
- Balconies, internal walls and floors are in place on Level 1.
